## **Year 6 Transition Evening Wednesday 1<sup>st</sup> July and Year 6 Transition Day Thursday 2<sup>nd</sup> July**

Transition day is the day that we welcome all our prospective Year 7 students to spend a full school day with us at Kingstone High School, in preparation for their first day on Thursday 3rd September 2025.

In addition, we are holding an evening event for parents, carers and your child on the evening before. You will have the opportunity to meet your child's new form tutor as well as the other key staff who will be working with your child.

### **Transition Evening Wednesday 1st July at 6pm; please arrive from 5:45pm onwards.**

This will give you all the opportunity to meet some of our key staff. They include:

- The Senior Leadership Team
- Mrs R Williams – Head of Year 7
- Mrs L Morris – Pastoral Lead for Year 7
- Year 7 Form Tutors

You will be able to collect a copy of the Parent Information Booklet 2026-27, gather information about uniform, meet members of the Parent Teacher Association, and ask any questions you may have.

### **Transition Day Thursday 2<sup>nd</sup> July**

- During the day the children will join their tutor group, take part in a variety of different lessons and get to experience a day in the life of Kingstone High School.
- It is the responsibility of parents/carers to transport their child to Kingstone.
- Your child should wear their normal primary school PE kit uniform with trainers, as they will be participating in a sports-related activity.
- At 08.50am, your child will be met at the side of the school by current pupils and members of staff. This area is in front of the canteen, which can be accessed through the entrance by the visitor car park. Here they will be registered. Staff and student leaders will be on hand to guide pupils.
- Please provide your child with a pencil case with basic equipment including pen, pencil, rubber and ruler.

- Please provide a water bottle for a drink of water and sun cream if it is a hot day. (Children will have access to a water fountain in the canteen.)
- Any medication they are required to take must be handed in into the school office. If your child has a prescribed asthma inhaler, they should keep this in their possession at all times.
- Lunch will be provided for your child and will include a drink. Your child will be welcome to bring additional snacks and a drink for break time. Please contact the school with any dietary requirements.
- Students will be escorted out to the front of the school at the end of the transition day, (3.00 pm), where they will meet parents/carers to make their way home.

We very much look forward to welcoming you and your child to the school and really hope that you will be able to attend the evening event.

Please could you let the school know if your child is able to attend Transition Day and whether you are able to attend the Evening Event, or not.
