RE: SPARX Homework for Maths, Login Information

You are receiving this letter because your son/daughter has failed to complete the compulsory aspect of their maths homework on the SPARX website.

All students have been given their username. Passwords are then managed by the student themselves, and not by teachers. If you are having problems logging on you will need the following information:

Visit the SPARX website.

Start typing in 'Kingstone High School' until it appears in the drop down menu. Then select it.
