Topics to Revise & Success Criteria	<u>English Language Paper 1 19th C Texts</u> - You will answer reading questions 1-4 on a 19th century narrative extract - You will be assessed against the following assessment objectives: AO1 – find and select clear and hidden points from a text AO2 – Language and Structure terminology AO4 – Evaluate: judge how well the writer of a text has achieved their intention The Key Assessment will feature analytical style questions and recall questions based on key terminology linked to language and structure. These questions will focus on small sections of the extract. The main part of the exam will be your evaluation of the whole extract. <u>Success Criteria</u> - Showing your understanding of what you have read through, identifying key information from a text - Recall of language and structure terminology - An extended evaluative response that offers a critical judgement of how well the writer has achieved their intention in a text. You should make reference to the following areas: setting, tone, ideas, language, events, structure to support your view. You should also use critical adverbs (judgement words) such as effectively, successfully, powerfully . . .

Written Assessment

You will complete a **written assessment** to show your understanding of the topics we have covered this half term. The assessment will include questions where you will need to **explain, describe, and give examples**.

You will be assessed on your knowledge, your ability to apply it to real-life situations, and your understanding of how food works in a healthy diet.

The topics that will be included are:

1. Sensory Analysis

- What sensory analysis is and why it is important in food.
- The five senses used in sensory analysis (sight, smell, taste, touch, sound).
- How sensory analysis affects customer choices and food product development.

2. Food Safety and Hygiene

- Main causes of foodborne illness and the role of bacteria.
- Personal hygiene rules in the kitchen.
- What cross-contamination is and how to prevent it.
- The importance of temperature control when storing or cooking food.

3. Eatwell Guide and Healthy Eating

- What the Eatwell Guide is and how it helps people eat a balanced diet.

	• The five main food groups and examples of foods in each. • Why a balanced diet is important for health and energy. 4. Multicultural Foods • What multicultural foods are and why they are important. • Examples of multicultural dishes: ingredients, origin, and nutritional benefits. • How globalization affects the availability and popularity of multicultural foods. 5. Protein • The role of protein in the body. • Difference between essential and non-essential amino acids. • Examples of high biological value (HBV) and low biological value (LBV) proteins. 6. Protein Complementation and Alternatives • What protein complementation is and why it is important. • Examples of complementary protein combinations. • Protein alternatives (e.g., tofu, tempeh, legumes) and their benefits. • How protein alternatives are used in vegetarian and vegan diets.

Topics to Revise & Success Criteria	<u>Component 1 Exploring the Media Section A</u> The Key Assessment will comprise questions 1a – c on one of the set texts. This will ask students to analyse the use of media techniques and devices they have studied in class. They will be provided with a clean copy of the text. Question 2a and 2b will ask about the context of a second set product and then ask them to compare this with an unseen product. Students will get clean copies of these. You need to review THIS GIRL CAN and the VOGUE magazine cover. <u>Success Criteria</u> • Be able to identify and explain the use of media terminology, discussing the impact on the audience and linking their ideas to the product • To recall and explain the context of the products they have studied • To compare and contrast a seen product with an unseen one, looking at how gender is represented
