The main part of the exam will be an extended answer on a character from the text. <u>Success Criteria</u> • Make a clear point using the words from the question • Used evidence from the text to support your point • Explained what the evidence suggests • Use the character's name in every paragraph • Mention how the reader reacts • Accurate use of SPaG • Make use of keywords including: Legendary, heroic, protagonist, antagonist

Exam Length	60 minutes
Topics to Revise & Success Criteria	<u>Practical Assessment</u> Each student will take part in a practical lesson where they will be assessed on the skills and knowledge developed throughout this half term. During the assessment, students will demonstrate their ability to: • Work safely and hygienically • Select and use the correct equipment • Operate a cooker confidently and correctly • Apply effective knife skills • Work at an efficient and consistent pace • Work independently with minimal guidance
Topics to Revise & Success Criteria	<u>Written Assessment</u> Each student will complete a written assessment to demonstrate their understanding of the key topics studied this half term. The assessment will test both knowledge and the ability to apply learning in different contexts. Students will be expected to: • Explain the importance of personal hygiene in food preparation and its role in preventing contamination • Identify and apply key principles of health and safety in the kitchen • Describe how bacteria grow and spread, and outline effective methods of ensuring food safety • Use the Eatwell Guide to show understanding of a balanced diet and healthy eating choices • Discuss the role of vitamins and minerals in maintaining health and wellbeing • Evaluate the impact of fats in the diet, considering both positive functions and potential health risks.
