Topics to Revise	Key Assessment 3 = GL Progress Test. The GL Progress Test in English is a national assessment used by schools to check how well you're developing your English skills compared to other
&	students your age across the country. It will assess:
Success Criteria	 Reading – how well you understand different types of texts (like fiction, non-fiction, and poetry), including your ability to find information, understand vocabulary, and make inferences. Spelling, Punctuation & Grammar (SPaG) – your knowledge of English grammar rules, punctuation, and accurate spelling. The test will be online. You'll answer a mix of multiple-choice questions and short written responses. The test takes about 45 to 60 minutes,
